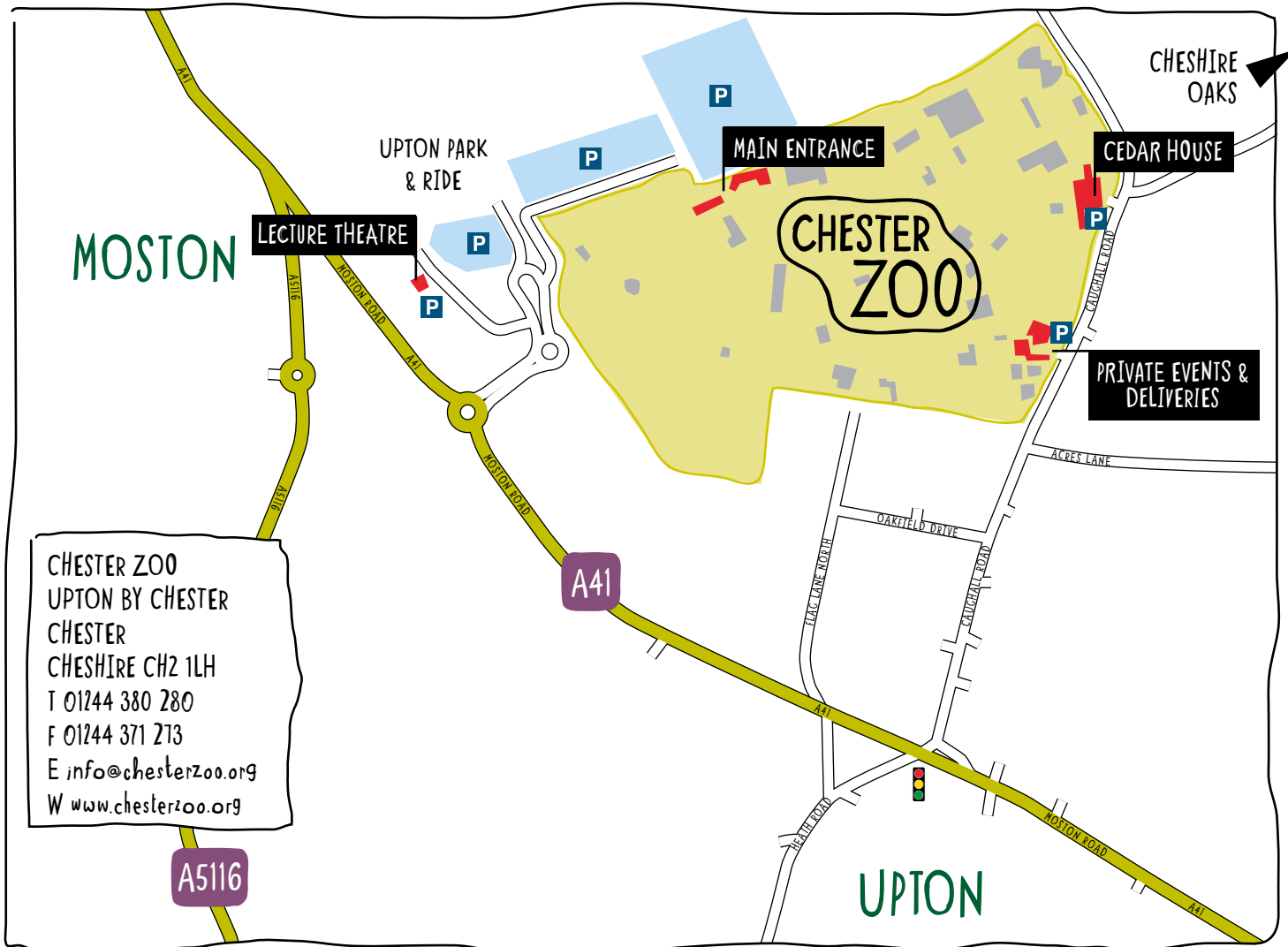
For the **MAIN ZOO ENTRANCE** and **LECTURE THEATRE** use **SAT NAV CH2 1EU**

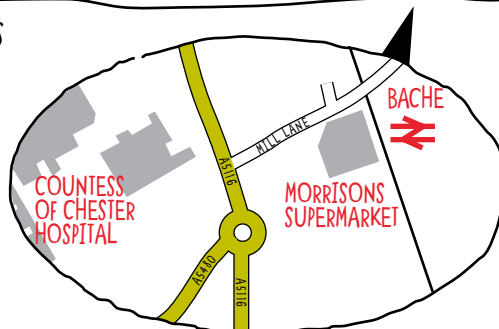
BIRKENHEAD, ELLESMERE PORT & M53 J10

BACHE STATION - served by **MERSEYRAIL** on its Chester to Liverpool line. Trains are every 15 minutes during peak times from Liverpool, Birkenhead and Chester. Take the **FIRST BUS** service **No.1** from outside the station (every 20 minutes everyday.)
