Item 7b: Investment pipeline

- Vortex (Newport Business Park) investment case approved by P&I Committee. Progress has slowed down on the development due to planning and we have still not agreed the final grant allocation.
- Quadrant Phase 3 (Birchwood Park) a business case for investment in Quadrant Phase 3 (153,000 sq ft industrial floorspace) was received on 08 March, which Cushman & Wakefield are currently appraising. Expect to come to the May Board for consideration.

- Alderley Park a business case for investment in 120,000 sq ft of new lab space was received on 11 March, which Cushman & Wakefield are currently appraising. Expect to come to the May Board for consideration.
- Enviroo (Protos) awaiting revised business case in response to queries raised by Cushman & Wakefield.
- Waste to Hydrogen Plant (Protos) awaiting revised business case has been received from Peel NRE for their proposed waste to hydrogen plant at Protos. The Growth Director and Cushman & Wakefield have provided feedback and Peel NRE are currently revising. Expect to come forward to either the March or May Growth Corridors Board for consideration.
- Thornton Science Park University of Chester is currently in the process of selecting its preferred investment partner for Thornton Science Park.
