

Cheshire and Warrington Labour Market - Catering Pathway

The Cheshire and Warrington Data and Labour Market Steering Group have commissioned this work which takes the qualification pathways that have been developed by the Institute for Apprenticeships and Technical Education, mapping different occupations against them and contextualising them for the Cheshire and Warrington economy.

Catering jobs in Cheshire and Warrington²

- In 2021, there were just over 20k of these jobs in Cheshire and Warrington³.
- About 2k of these jobs were at Level 3 and the 18.5k were at Level 2.



- Over the next ten years, about a third of these jobs will need to be filled by new entrants because of retirements and similar.
- Most of these jobs have a medium to high risk of automation in the future.
- There are about the same number of jobs like this in Cheshire and Warrington as would be expected from the national average.


Age profile of Catering jobs

Job postings⁴

- In the last five years, there have been about 21k unique job postings for this type of job in C&W (excluding staffing companies) with about 10k in Cheshire West and Chester, 8k in Cheshire East, and 3.5k in Warrington.
- These jobs were mainly advertised in Chester (4,791); Warrington (2,948); Northwich (1,599); Crewe (1,565); Macclesfield (1,338); Ellesmere Port (934); Knutsford (924); Wilmslow (839); Nantwich (667); and Alderley Edge (620).
- Top recruiters in Cheshire and Warrington (excluding staffing agencies) include Brunning & Price, Mitchells & Butlers, Catermatch Solutions, Hydes Brewery, McDonald's, Marston's, Compass Group, Pizza Hut, and J D Wetherspoon.
- The most frequently advertised job titles in Cheshire and Warrington are for Sous Chefs, Chefs, Kitchen Assistants, Kitchen Porters, Head Chefs, Commis Chefs, Team Members, Catering Assistants, Kitchen Team Members.

Apprenticeships

In the past five years, there have been 994 apprenticeships advertised in Catering occupations in Cheshire and Warrington. These were advertised in most parts of Cheshire and Warrington and were mostly for apprentice Chefs. Employers advertising for apprentices included Mitchells & Butlers, Spirit Pub Company, Lifetime, Marston's, Harvester, Brunning & Price, Kilton Inn' and the Chester Grosvenor Hotel.

In 2019/20, there were 81 apprenticeship starts in Catering jobs. The number will have been depressed by the pandemic. Most opportunities were at Level 2.

College Courses

The main college-based catering qualifications delivered to young people resident in Cheshire and Warrington aged 16-18 in 2019/20 are shown in the table below. Most were at Level 1. The Government is introducing a T-level in Catering which will be rolled out over the next few years.
